


HOW TO USE THE BOOK BIN LABELS

- **1. Print** We recommend printing the labels on a thick white paper, such as cardstock.
- 2. Laminate This step is optional, but the labels will be more durable if they are laminated.
- **3. Attach** Labels can be attached to your book bins in whatever way you choose. We love peel and stick Velcro for laminated labels (it's easy to reorganize or replace labels) or clear packing tape for unlaminated labels (one piece of tape across the entire label works best).
- **4. Enjoy** Step back and admire your newly organized classroom library!




