## HOW TO USE THE BOOK BIN LABELS

- 1. Print** – We recommend printing the labels on a thick white paper, such as cardstock.
- 2. Laminate** – This step is optional, but the labels will be more durable if they are laminated.
- 3. Attach** – Labels can be attached to your book bins in whatever way you choose. We love peel and stick Velcro for laminated labels (it's easy to re-organize or replace labels) or clear packing tape for unlaminated labels (one piece of tape across the entire label works best).
- 4. Enjoy** – Step back and admire your newly organized classroom library!
