## LET'S WRITE A Diamante Poem

*A diamante poem uses nouns, adjectives, and verbs to describe a set of synonyms or antonyms found in the first and last lines. The poem takes on the shape of a diamond as it is written.*

## LET'S WRITE A Limerick Poem

*A silly five line poem that is often funny or nonsensical. They usually start with "There once was a..."  
Lines 1, 2, and 5 rhyme and have the same number of syllables; Lines 3 and 4 rhyme and have the same number of syllables.*



8 or 9 syllables; rhymes with lines 2 and 5

8 or 9 syllables; rhymes with lines 1 and 5

5 or 6 syllables; rhymes with line 4

5 or 6 syllables; rhymes with line 3

8 or 9 syllables; rhymes with lines 1 and 2; often silly or unexpected



*Try writing about a funny story you've heard, or a silly experience you've had.*
